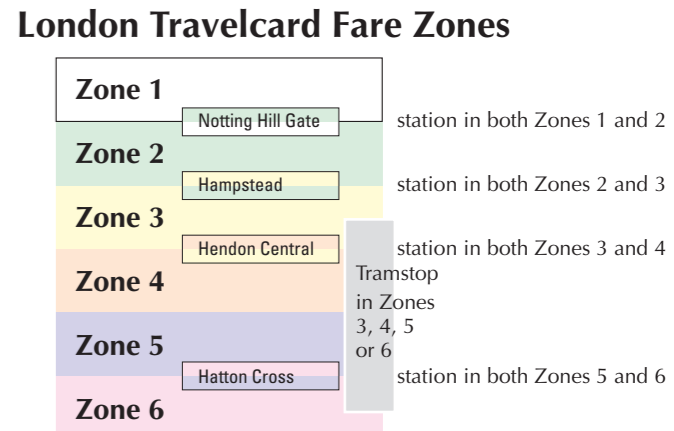
A few services do not operate and some stations are not served in the early mornings and late evenings, or at weekends and on public holidays.
