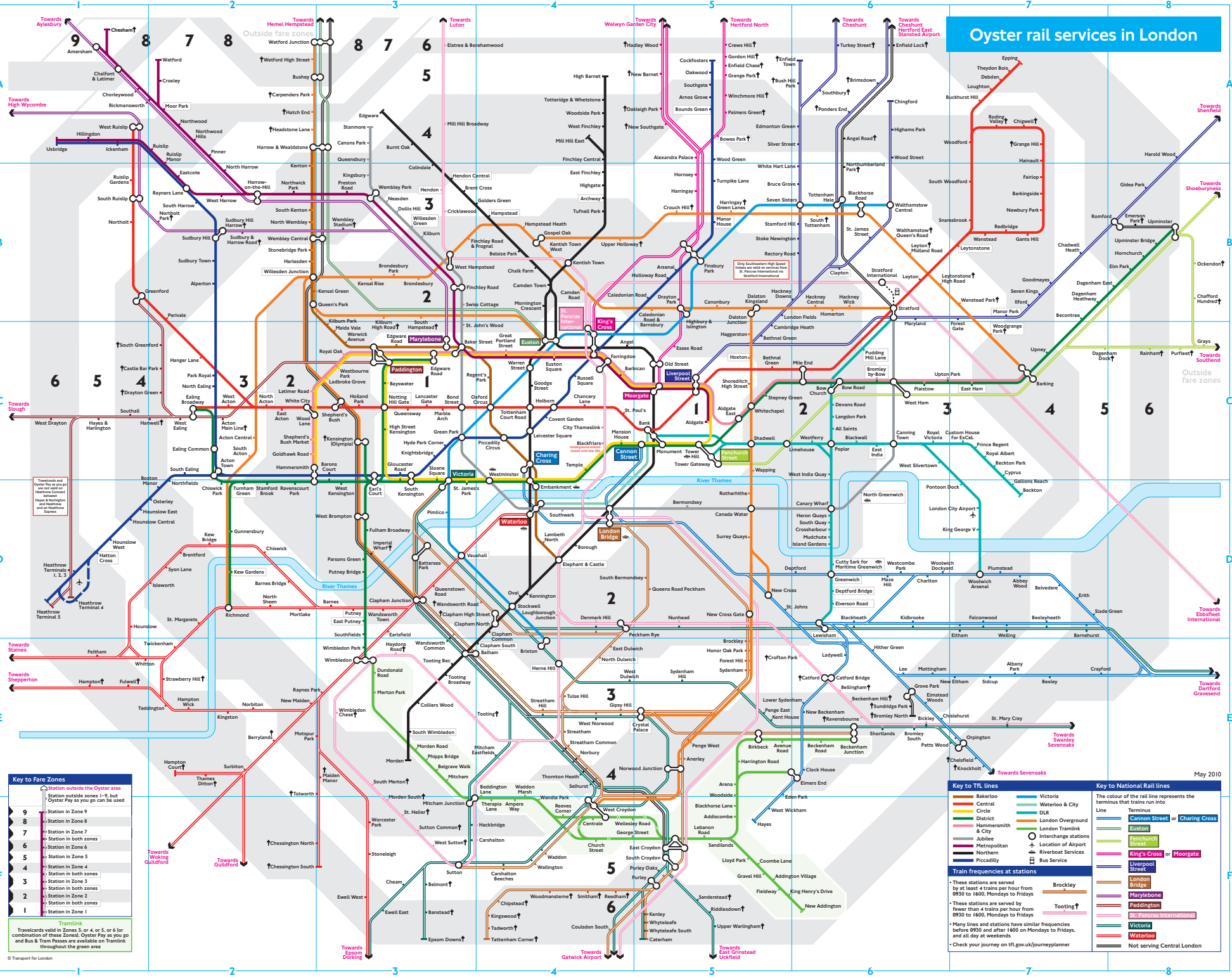


# Oyster rail services in London



**Key to Fare Zones**

Station outside the Oyster area  
Station outside zones 1-9, but Oyster Pay as you go can be used

9 Station in Zone 9  
8 Station in Zone 8  
7 Station in Zone 7  
6 Station in both zones  
5 Station in Zone 5  
4 Station in Zone 4  
3 Station in both zones  
2 Station in Zone 2  
1 Station in Zone 1

Tramlink  
Travelcards valid in Zones 3, 4, 5, or 6, or 4, 5, or 6 for combination of these Zones. Oyster Pay as you go and Bus & Tram Passes are available on Tramlink throughout the green area

**Train frequencies at stations**

These stations are served by at least 4 trains per hour from 0930 to 1600, Mondays to Fridays

These stations are served by fewer than 4 trains per hour from 0930 to 1600, Mondays to Fridays

Many lines and stations have similar frequencies before 0930 and after 1600 on Mondays to Fridays, and all day at weekends
