

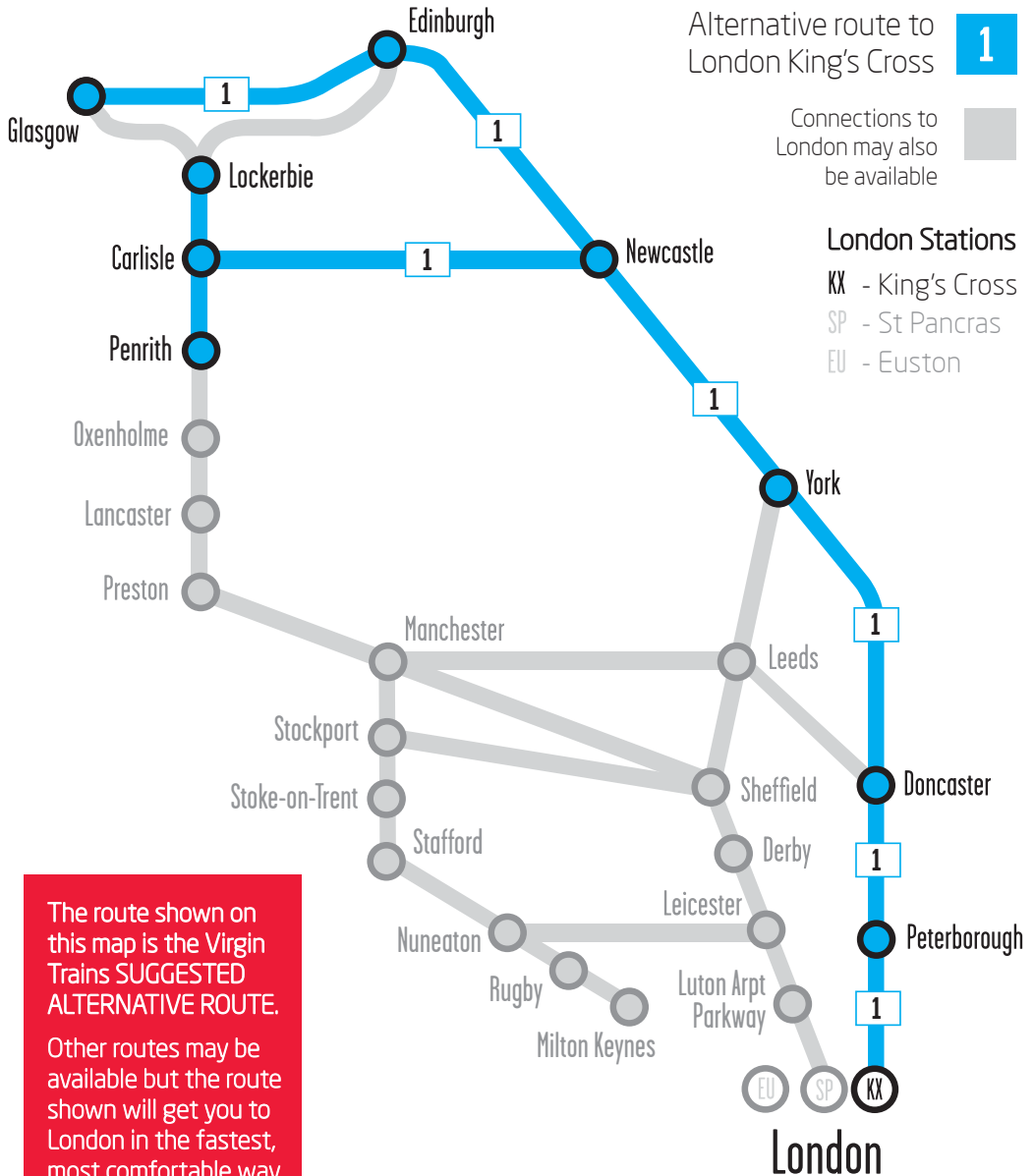

We are sorry to advise that there are currently no Virgin Trains services running to/from London Euston due to a line blockage at the southern end of the West Coast Main Line.

Please use the map on the reverse of this leaflet to find the alternative route for your journey. Your ticket will be valid. Our staff will be pleased to help with more information.

As you are likely to be delayed you may be entitled to compensation in line with our Passenger's Charter. The amount is based upon the length of delay and is paid in rail travel vouchers:

Delay over 60 minutes = 25% of ticket cost for journey.
Over 120 minutes = full ticket cost for journey.

In order to claim and validate your journey, we need to receive your travel tickets. Please send your original tickets, along with journey details including date and time of travel, to our Customer Relations team at the postal address below:

Journey Checklist

When travelling to London via an alternative route, always remember...

- ✓ **Check your changes.** The usual Virgin Trains route to London may not involve any changes, but your alternative could involve 1 or 2.
- ✓ **Check your times.** In order to get to London in the quickest time possible, check where and when you need to change trains.
- ✓ **Bring a snack or two.** The level of catering or First Class service you expect on Virgin Trains may not always be available on other train operators services.
- ✓ **If in doubt, ask!** If you have any problems, staff at this station, or any station en route to London, will be more than happy to help you.

- 1** Route 1 arrives into King's Cross located approx 1 mile east of Euston
- 2** Route 2 arrives into St.Pancras located approx 0.5 mile east of Euston
- 3A** Route 3A arrives into Marylebone located approx 2 miles west of Euston
- 3B 4** Routes 3B & 4 arrive into Paddington located approx 2.5 miles west of Euston
